<p>Visa</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All international students are required to apply for a Non-Immigrant Entry Visa code "ED" for the purpose of their stay in Thailand, prior to arrival. • A Non-Immigrant Entry Visa code "ED" costs 2,000 THB (60 USD, 40 EUR – subject to change) 																											
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>All International students are required to purchase health insurance during your stay in Thailand especially an insurance policy covering health care and treatment expenses for COVID-19 disease with a coverage of no less than 10,000 USD *subject to change without notice</p>																											

Application Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Contact the International Office of your Home University *If qualified, the international office of your home university will send you a link for an online Application Form to the Global Relations Division (GRD) 2. The Global Relations Division GRD will send your application form and related document to the School 3. The School will send the result back to GRD within 2-3 weeks 4. Mae Fah Luang University will issue the Acceptance Letter to the international office of your home university by email and post (within two-three weeks after submitted completed application materials). 5. Mae Fah Luang University will send original copy of the Acceptance Letter by postal mail to your home university 6. *If qualified, you should apply for Non-Immigrant entry visa code “ED” (Student VISA) to the nearest Thai Embassy in your country 7. Fill in the Acceptance and Arrival Form and inform the flight information to GRD (We'll arrange the pick-up service for you-free of charge) 8. Arrival in Chiang Rai, Thailand

On Campus Dormitory	<p>The University has increased its accommodation capacity and offers up to 5,000 beds in 16 dormitory buildings for students.</p> <p>Students' residences are just a ten-minute walk from the main university buildings. Students have privacy within a safe, friendly, and lively learning environment.</p> <p>All exchange students are recommended to stay in the dormitories with the intention of encouraging students to develop their social skills through living together, learning together, and helping one another.</p> <p>The student dormitories, which are supervised by University staff and guarded round the clock by security officers, provide desks, beds and mattresses, internet corners, TV rooms and study rooms.</p>
